Focus for this meeting is brainstorming an outreach and action plan to increase the diversity among Town Meeting Members – now and in the future.

- Collaboration of the DTG and the Sudanese Education Fund

- Planning for the Second Annual Diversity/Disability Job Fair
 in collaboration with the Disability Commission. April 8, 11:00am to 2:00pm,
 Arlington Town Hall
- 3. Brainstorming our new project: Increasing the Diversity among Town Meeting Members.
 - Discussion of strategies proposed by informal initial brainstorming meetings among the Arlington League of Women Voters; the Governance and Diversity Task Groups of Vision 2020; the Arlington African American Society.
 - Action Plan for the next weeks leading up to the April 10 Arlington Election for Town Meeting members.
 Focus is on recruiting people as write in candidates who can bring diverse voices and perspectives to Town Meeting. Often write-in candidates can win a Town Meeting Seat with just 3 or 4 votes (including a vote for themselves).
- What has been done so far
- What needs to be done, including distributing posters around town and possibly in Arlington churches, outreach to people who might be interested in running and assisting them with the logistics, and others.
- Who will do what?

- Creation of a longer-range public education, outreach and action plan. Some questions to consider:
- Who are our target audiences?
- How do we reach them?
- What other groups may have an interest in the project and in collaborating with it?
- 4. Should we meet monthly from now through June to work on the Increasing the Diversity Among Town Meeting Members project? (We decided a while ago to meet every other month).
