COORDINATOR'S REPORT: Charlotte provided an update (Ref 1) on diversion. The numbers are similar to last year. She plans to use 20,000 HH to provide the per household number to the State. She plans to go house to house on collection days in March to carry out an audit. She will count # trash barrels, # bulky items etc.

BUSINESS RECYCLING: The SubCom has received 130 survey returns. They plan to network in the 3 business centers.

ECOFEST PRESENTATIONS: General discussion of laptop-based "flip charts". Agreed that max number of charts would be 20 & display interval would be 5 sec. Charlotte will review the preliminary slides to be sure they cover the areas where she gets questions or has concerns.

PLASTIC FILM RECYCLING: Juli outlined what needs to be done initially. Laura volunteered to take this on.

EDUCATION CAMPAIGN TARGETS: Sue suggested that we request a Recycling Corner in the Advocate. Gordon volunteered to update op ed's that were published before and submit them under a standard banner. He will try for 1/mo including 20,000 HH, paper paper paper, and collection bins, composting and keeping your trash dry. This effort is in addition to Charlotte's DPW articles.

BRACKET COMPOSTING: Erica reported that Whole Foods will take all the Bracket lunch cafeteria food waste into their composting program including compostable lunch trays which have just begun being used.


