2013 STORMWATER AWARENESS SERIES

SESSION 1 – PERMEABLE PAVERS

The Town of Arlington Engineering Division is hosting a Stormwater Awareness Series open to residents of the Town of Arlington and the general public.

The series is designed to educate residents on Stormwater and the impacts on runoff, water quality, flood control and prevention, erosion and other stormwater related impacts within the Town of Arlington. Information will be provided by stormwater professionals for the purpose of increasing awareness of these issues within the Town and to provide information for residents to help understand how the surrounding environment affects, and impacts, the local water resources and what can be done to reduce these impacts.

Larry Nicolai is the Senior Vice President of Ideal Concrete Block Company, Inc., a New England based manufacturer of concrete masonry products. Larry is the founding chairman of the Interlocking Concrete Pavement Institute where he continues to serve on the Board of Directors. He also was the chairman of the ICPI Foundation for Education and Research for 3 years and currently serves as a Trustee. Larry serves as a director on the board of the New Concrete Masonry Association Board and holds the position of Chairman-elect.

Larry is a certified instructor and has authored curriculum for the construction of interlocking concrete pavements and segmental retaining walls. The presentation will discuss how infiltration is a highly effective method in mitigating the effects and the advantages permeable pavers offer homeowners as an on-site solution – from selection to installation.
