




Left-turn Lane with Through Traffic - Massachusetts Avenue at Lake Street

Bus Pull-off with Through Traffic - Massachusetts Avenue at Thorndike Street





### How We Get There - I

- Approx. 2 Construction Seasons:
  - Spring 2014 to Spring 2016
  - Job will slow or stop December to March:
    - Signals, lighting, street furnishings can progress
  - Work will run from Pond Lane to Alewife Brook Parkway.





### How We Get There - II

- July-August 2014:
  - Drainage/water work
  - NSTAR/RCN/Comcast/Verizon
  - Short-term water interruptions
    - 72 hours advance notice—less than 1 day
- Sidewalks:
  - Pond Lane to Winter Street (fall 2014)
  - Winter Street to Alewife Brook (spring 2015)
  - Pond Lane to Orvis Street (spring/summer, 2015)
  - Orvis Street to Alewife Brook (summer 2015)
- Roadway resurfacing (fall 2015)
- Full beneficial use (fall 2015)
- Landscaping (fall 2015)
- Full completion (spring 2016)





### Some FAQ's

#### Question

How long is the project?

What's the sequence of the job?

Is there night work expected?


Is there weekend work expected?

How will driveway access be maintained during sidewalk work?

#### Answer

Approximately 2 construction seasons, spring 2014 to spring 2016.

- 1. Utilities
- 2. Sidewalks
- 3. Roadway reconstruction
- 4. Landscaping



Not at present. Approval would be subject to DOT and Town of Arlington review.

Maximum driveway closures will be 3 days to allow concrete to cure. 48 hours notice will be provided. Temporary access will be maintained via graveled space.





### Some More FAQ's

#### Question

How will Massachusetts Avenue be repaved?

What about MBTA bus service?

What about merchant deliveries?

What about emission control for contractor machinery?

#### Answer

At night, in a continuous section. Traffic will be maintained with cones.



MBTA bus service will be maintained throughout construction. Some temporary stop relocations may be required.

Deliveries will be maintained throughout construction.

All machinery will adhere to MassDOT emission control standards. Anti-idling measures will be enforced.
