DPW Construction Projects: 2014 Water Line Rehabilitation Construction began in Fall 2013

As part of the Town's ongoing Capital Improvement Program, the Department of Public Works will be coordinating the rehabilitation of various water lines throughout Town. Work will consist of installation of temporary by-pass lines, water line removal/replacement and replacement of water service connections. This work began in the Fall of 2013 and will begin again in June 2014 and extend into the Summer of 2014 (weather dependent).

Project areas include the following roads/sections:

Main Replacement Projects

Overlook Road Ronald Road Intersection of Summer St/Overlook Rd King Street (completed)Mt. Pleasant Cemetery (completed)

Valve Replacement/Additional Work:

Oakland Ave. & Park Ave. Pleasant St. & Kensington Park Mystic St. & Sachem Ave. (completed)

During this time residents should expect some on-street parking restrictions to allow for construction activities & equipment. The contractor will make every effort to keep inconveniences to a minimum and traffic police details will be present to aid in driveway access/egress and roadway safety. Residents are requested to observe on-street roadway postings, detour signs and traffic safety officers to aid traffic management efforts. Residents traveling through these areas should plan accordingly, allow for travel delays, and should consider alternative routes when possible.

Further notices will be provided to abutters as necessary. Water rehabilitation updates will be posted online at arlingtonma.gov/dpwprojects.
