Town of Arlington responses to questions for RFI No. 12-48 1-8-13

Does the City require 4 hard copies <u>each</u> of the RFP response and of the pricing proposal, plus 1 soft copy each of the RFP response and of the pricing proposal?

Yes, 4 paper copies each of the RFI response and pricing proposal and 1 electronic copy of the RFI response and pricing proposal. The electronic copy can be a CD or flash drive.

2. What billing system(s) does the City use - in particular, for your proprietary payments system? Does the City already have a web service for this application?

The Town of Arlington uses a proprietary system called ICS. The Town does have a web service for this application. The Town of Arlington hosts the front end and then sends the processing request to MCC.

3. How many rollbacks does the City deal with per month, on average?

The Town averages approximately 10-15 rollbacks per month.

4. Payment Metrics. In the chart provided on Page 15 of the RFP, does 'volume' equal bills issued, or payments received? And, for each category represented (Excise Tax, Real Estate Tax, Personal Property Tax and Water/Sewer), is the volume an annual amount? For example, in the excise tax category, does the 34,000 represent annual bills/payments (34,000 divided by 12 equalling 2,833 bills/payments per month) or 34,000 bills/payments per month?

Volume does equal the number of bills. The "volume annually" refers to the total number of the bills sent out during one fiscal year. Real estate and personal property bills are mailed out 4 times per year. While Water and Sewer bills are mailed out every month, Arlington households receive 2 bills per year. Excise tax bills are mailed 10 or 11 times per year with the majority (85%) of the excise tax bills mailed out in February of each year.

6. Section V, Evaluation Criteria, Qn 6. "Allow For Automatic Payment" -Please clarify your definition of Automatic Payment. What functionality or need are you trying to address?

Automatic refers to the vendor being able to accept electronic payments from a bank or financial institution. This is most commonly used when the taxpayer utilizes their personal checking account to pay a tax bill.

7. Section V, Evaluation Criteria, Qn 10. "Allow multiple bills to be paid at same time in one transaction" - What functionality or need are you trying to address?

The Town of Arlington is requesting that any vendor provide the ability to pay a real estate tax bill, a water and sewer bill and an excise tax bill at the same time rather than making the taxpayer sign in multiple times and have the transaction should show the separate payments.

How many web pages are involved in the Turn-Key solution and does each web page represent a specific transaction type and merchant account?

There are 4 pages.

Turnkey Payment requirements pg 9: Can the Town expand on the description of the requirement for a Bill Payment transactions (ACH) capability initiated from the bill payer/tax payer epayment program (Customer account website) from their banking institution.

The Town is requesting that the financial institution of any taxpayer be allowed to interact with the vendor in order to process the taxpayers payment.

Is the only required payment acceptance type ACH?

No. Credit and Debit cards are also required.

What is the customer account website that is referred to and who host this site?

The Treasurers website http://arlingtontreasurer.com, The Town of Arlington.

Proprietary Payments Requirements page 10: What is the company name, product name application and version including any service packs of the Town's Proprietary system and do all town departments and locations utilize this system?

The proprietary system is named ICS (Integrated Collection System. There are no versions to ICS. As stated above, the Town of Arlington hosts the front end of the transaction and MCC finishes the transaction.

Only the Treasurers department utilizes ICS.

Does the Town's Proprietary Payments systems have a built in payment processing interface and if so what is the company name, product name and version of the payment interface, and what processors does it interface to?

The proprietary system is named ICS (Integrated Collection System. There are no versions to ICS. As stated above, the Town of Arlington hosts the front end of the transaction and MCC finishes the transaction.

The information related to the taxpayers bill, which would include but not limited to the bill number, name and address and payment history.
