### SESSION #15: Stormwater Management; Financing Options

The Town of Arlington Engineering Division is hosting a Stormwater Awareness Series open to residents of the Town of Arlington and the general public.

The series is designed to educate residents on Stormwater and the impacts on runoff, water quality, flood control and prevention, erosion and other stormwater related impacts within the Town of Arlington. Information will be provided by stormwater professionals for the purpose of increasing awareness of these issues within the Town and to provide information for residents to help understand how the surrounding environment affects, and impacts, the local water resources and what can be done to reduce these impacts.

She assists MAPC managers in the implementation of Sustainable Communities programs and currently serves as project manager on the Regional Stormwater Funding/Utility Starter Kit to provide current information and tools regarding funding options that will improve water quality and quantity within regional watersheds. Ms. Conroy serves on the project team to develop a Regional Climate Change Adaptation Strategy; to prepare recommendations for local, regional, and state action to reduce vulnerability to future hazards and impacts of climate change. Ms. Conroy also serves as the Subregional Coordinator for the Minuteman Advisory on Interlocal Coordination (MAGIC).
