WATER MAIN REHABILITATION CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

The Town of Arlington wishes to take this opportunity to follow up on a Construction Notice that was mailed to you a few weeks ago. We are approaching the anticipated start of a Water Main Rehabilitation Project in your neighborhood as a reminder of the scope of work proposed and what can be expected during the course of construction.

Where: The Town of Arlington Department of Public Works will begin installation of a new 8" ductile iron water main on:

- Alpine Street
- High Haith Road (Spring Street to Longfellow Road)
- Branch Avenue
- Summer Street (Overlook Road to King Street)

Morris Street

• Summer Street (Overlook Road to King Street)

This project will be replacing pipes in the street that are approaching the end of their useful life or have been identified in our Capital Improvement Plan for the Town's Water Distribution System.

Who: The Town of Arlington Department of Public Works has contracted the construction work to Five Oaks Construction of Groton, Massachusetts. Town personnel will regularly be on-site overseeing and inspecting the construction.

When: The anticipated start date for the project is <u>June 01, 2015</u> with an anticipated duration of <u>3 months</u>. Weather and/or construction delays may impact this schedule.

How: In general, work will consist of the following:

- Install an above-ground temporary water main & service to each building within the project limits;
- Sawcut the limits of the proposed trench where the new water pipe will be installed;
- Excavate to remove the existing water main and install the new main;
- Backfill the excavations & install temporary pavement at the end of each work week within the trench limits;
- Perform pressure testing & bacteriological sampling on the newly installed water main;
- Install new copper service laterals from the newly installed water main to the curbside shutoff valve for each building within the project limits;
- When a permanent water service has been restored to every building, the above-ground temporary water main & services will be removed and the project site restored to its pre-construction condition.

What: In general, the following can be expected during construction:

- There will be a heavy presence of construction noise, vehicles, equipment, materials, & dust during construction hours;
- Access to driveways will be maintained during the course of work, although there may be minor delays while work is being conducted directly in front of your home;
- On-Street parking will be restricted in the work zone during work hours. This will
 assist the contractor in completing work in a timely fashion.
- Police Traffic Safety Detail Officers will be on-site to assist with driveway access and egress during construction;
- Short interruptions to your water service may be required to make connections and
 install isolation control valves in the water system. These outages will be scheduled
 and planned so as to minimize impacts. You will receive advance notification when
 these temporary outages will be required.
