RE: DPW Construction Project Update - 2015 Water Main Rehabilitation Project

As part of the Town's ongoing Capital Improvement Program, the Department of Public Works, has be coordinating the rehabilitation of various water mains throughout Town. Work has consisted of installation of temporary bypass lines, water line removal/replacement and replacement of water service laterals. This work began in the Spring of 2015 -- please find an update on the progress of this work below:

Work Location	Status	Comments
Alpine Street Area	Ongoing	A new 8" ductile iron water main, isolation control valves, & new fire hydrants have been installed on Alpine Street from Summer Street to #35 Alpine Street. New water main still needs to be installed on the remainder of Alpine Street, Morris Avenue, and Branch Avenue before new copper service laterals need to be installed between the new main and sidewalk curb-stop box.
Summer Street (King St #409 Summer St.)	Outstanding	Work is Scheduled for Late July.
High Haith Road (Longfellow Rd Spring St.)	Outstanding	Work is Scheduled for Early August.

During this time, expect lane restrictions, parking restrictions, and construction vehicle presence. The Engineering Division also asks that motorists comply with the following:

- Please adhere to the No Parking postings within the work limits.
- Please proceed with caution & observe all directional signs & barriers.
- Please comply with instructions from Traffic Safety Detail Officers to facilitate the safe flow of traffic in an orderly manner.
- Please be aware of heavy equipment entering and exiting the site.
- Please drive with caution and reduced speeds within the work zone limits.

As always, the contractor will make every effort to keep inconveniences to a minimum and traffic police safety details will be present during the entire work process.
