Yard Waste – What is accepted at the curb in Arlington

* Yard waste is NEVER accepted in plastic bags. Paper leaf and lawn bags and clearly marked resuable barrels ONLY
 * No item can weigh more than 50 lbs.
 *No branch thicker than 1" in diameter

Yard Waste – What is accepted at the curb in Arlington One inch thick or less ONLY


The Lexington Compost Facility only accepts thin sticks, so we can only take thin sticks at the curb



This stick is on the border, almost too thick. Use your judgment
