# Item 4 Grant cycle

#### 4.1 Community Input update

Scott reported that about 150 people have filled out the survey. He has placed the results in dropbox. Scott recommends looking online as the hardcopy versions are very difficult to read. There are two files; a stats document with quantifiable answers, and a separate file for free text comments. Many addresses and email addresses are included, the corresponding secretary should follow up to gather that information for future use. Scott will put together a summary. He has noted much talk about public art and the Night at the Tower. The surveys also include information about where they heard about ACC. Other comments show that people with kids want more child oriented events, others want more adult oriented events.

# 4.2 Updating grant guidelines

Elisabeth suggested adding a raindate for outdoor events as part of the guidelines. New guidelines must be posted by 9/1/15. Elisabeth volunteered to update the guidelines from last year based on Scott's summary of the community input survey. The council will vote on the new version at our August meeting.
