ITEM 1 Approval of October minutes

ITEM 3 Treasurer's Report/Calculating Amount Available for Granting

The council has been allocated \$12,300 from the MCC for 2016. Local councils can hold up to 5% of the allocation for expenses, which would be \$615. There is also a \$71 carry over from 2015 that was not spent by a grantee. Due to a change in treasurers, exact figures for other money available to the council were not available. The council voted to allocate \$12,000 at this meeting, with the provision that a completed Treasurer's report be available at the December meeting. Based on that report, allocations may be adjust slightly. Karin will meet with Jeff T., and perhaps past treasurer Sharon Shaloo to ensure completion of the treasurer's report. Joe may also attend.

ITEM 4 Deliberations

Karin began by proposing the process to be followed for deliberation. Deliberations began at 2:01pm.

The Council unanimously decided to fund (either wholly or partially) 17 out of 27 grant applications for a total of \$12,000. Grant size ranged from \$200 to \$1,500. The council reviewed the reasons for not approving the remaining 10 applications, and Elisabeth will be sending out letters of explanation to these applicants. Additionally, the council felt that a few applicants would benefit from additional guidance from a council member for future years. Lauren, Elisabeth, Joe and Nilou will follow up with various applicants.

ITEM 5 Vote on Prospective Members

The council voted to recommend the appointment of Sherry Greene with one abstention.
