Re: Phase # 8 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project

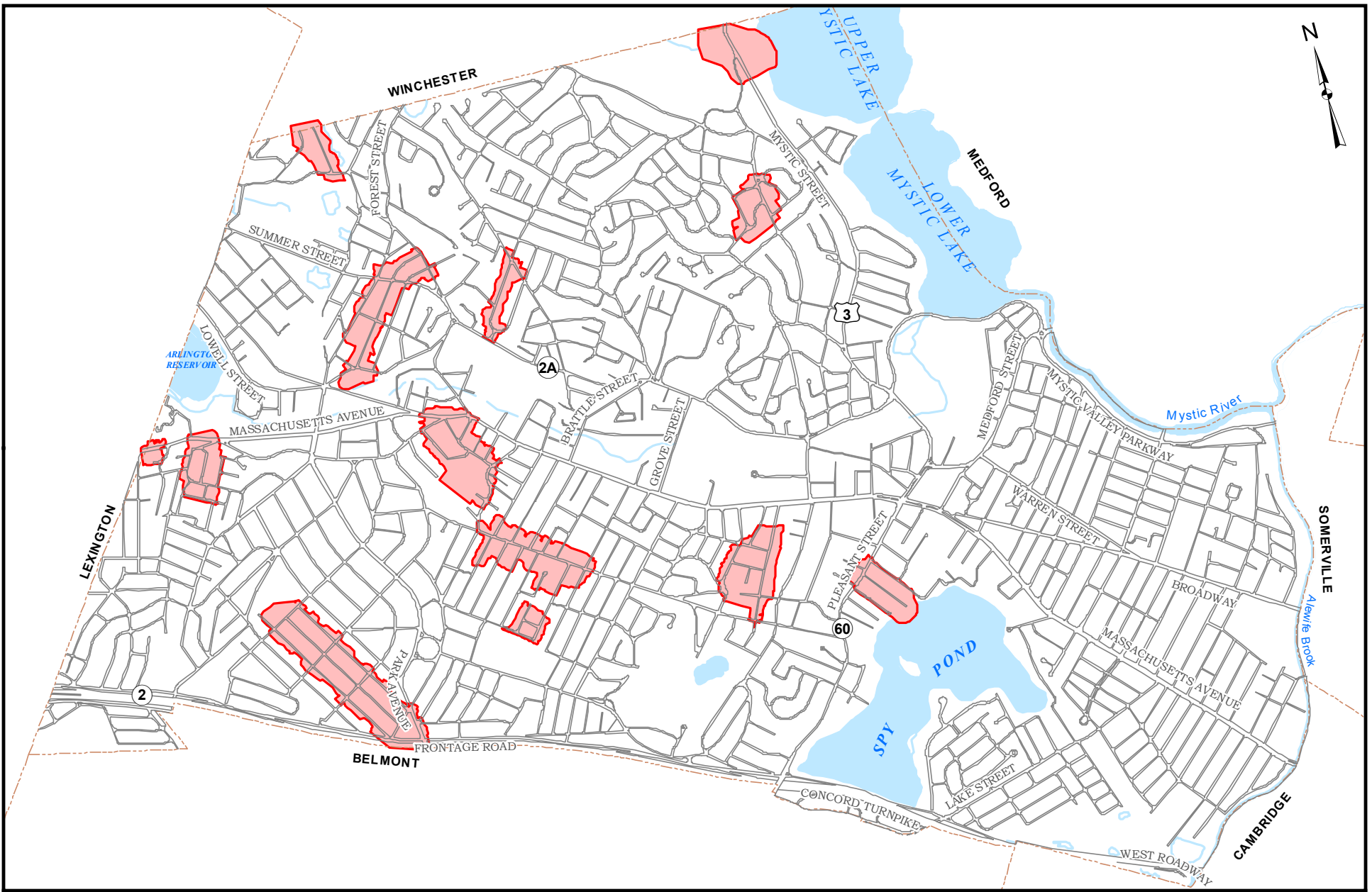
The Town of Arlington has initiated a program to reduce the amount of groundwater (infiltration) and rainwater (inflow) entering the sewer system. Through this program, sources of Infiltration and Inflow (I/I) will be identified and removed. When these sources are removed, the quantity of flow entering the Arlington sewer system and the risk of sewer backups and overflows will be reduced.

The Town's Contractors, National Water Main Cleaning Company, Insituform Technology Inc., and D'Alessandro Construction will be conducting sewer manhole and sewer pipe repairs as part of the Phase # 8 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project.

Crews will be working between August 8, 2016 and December 31, 2016. The work will be performed Monday through Friday, between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Further notifications will be provided as the work advances.

Persons performing the work will be in clearly marked trucks and will be wearing bright shirts or vests. Work will be conducted primarily within the Town's right-of-way and private residences should not be affected.

The areas included in this project are highlighted on the attached locus map.

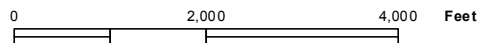


 **PHASE #8 SEWER REHABILITATION AREAS**
