Approval of the minutes, May 28, 2009 – Moved by Joe Curro, seconded by Leba Heigham – approved with a 3-0 vote.

#### Fees fund

We discussed the next steps that need to happen in order to create and move forward with the fee fund. We looked into the policy and procedure handbook to decide how such a committee could be created and it looks like policies BDF & KCC both might pertain. There was much discussion about how to define the make-up of the committee. We agreed that the following were the correct next steps:

- 1. Community relations affirms the fund, provides guidance around how it is set up and expended, and which 7 people make up the advisory committee (those who promote and direct fund raising for the fee)
- School committee refers to policy and procedures.
- 3. Policy and procedures signs off on this policy adhering to policy BDF Advisory Committees to the School Committee and KCC Private donations to the public schools.
- 4. School committee adopts policy (this takes two meetings -- one reading and one acceptance)
- 5. CFO creates fund with comptroller
- 6. Fund committee publicizes and begins to collect funds
