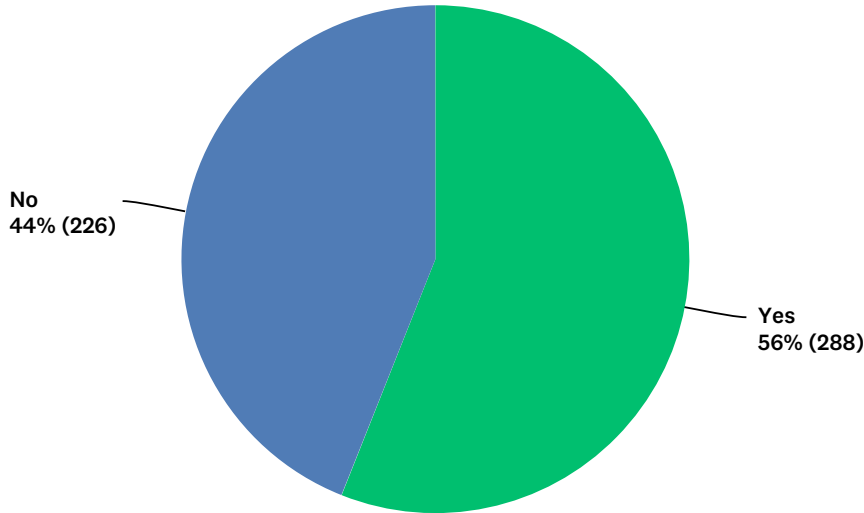


Q1 Before starting this survey, did you know that this space is named Whittemore Park?

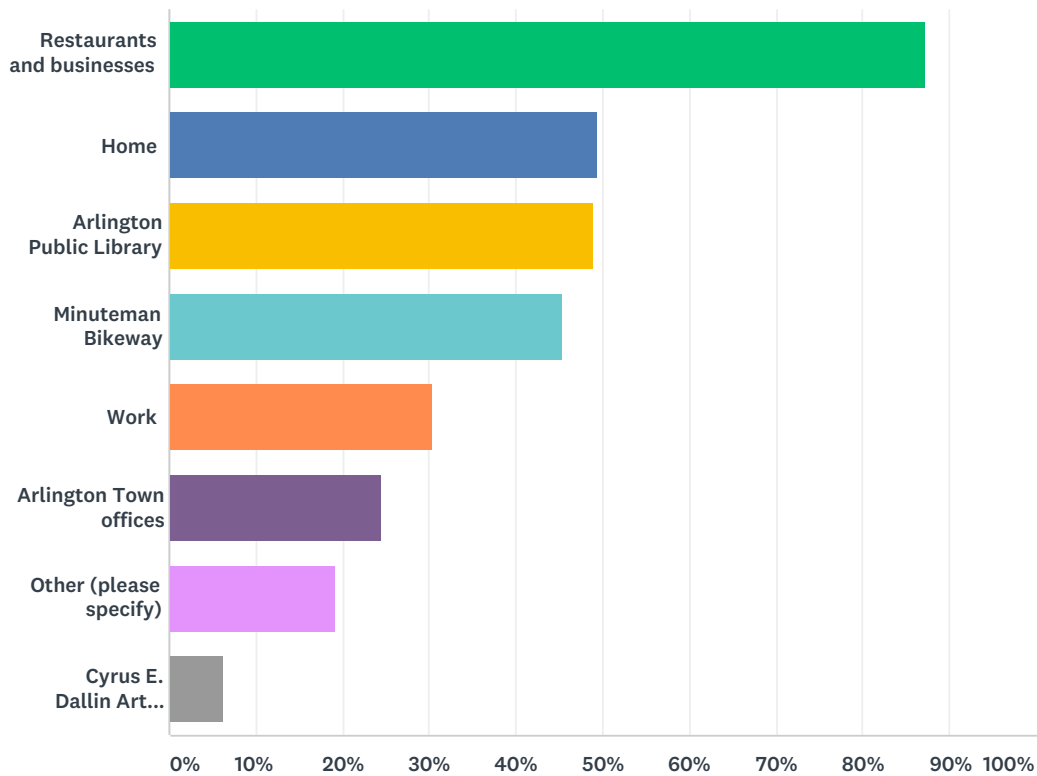

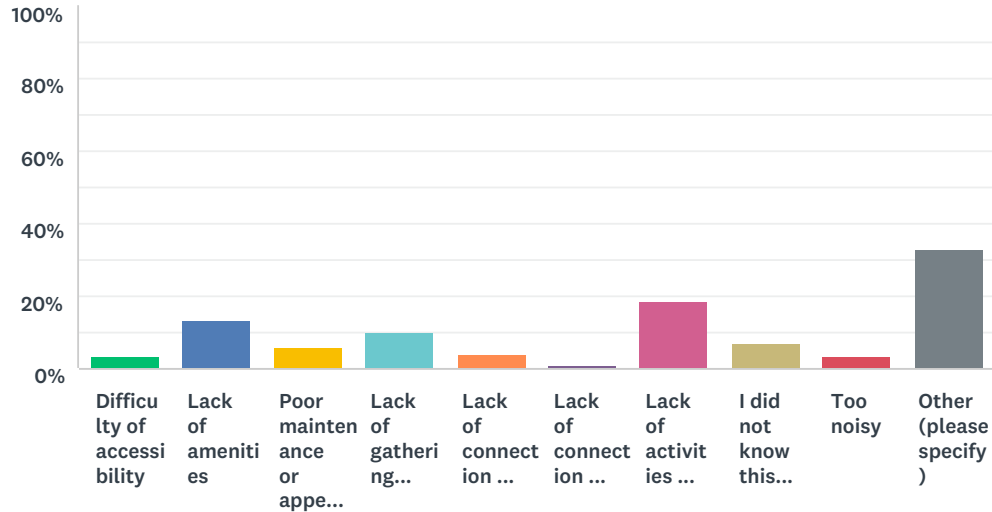

Q6 On average, how long do you stay in Whittemore Park?

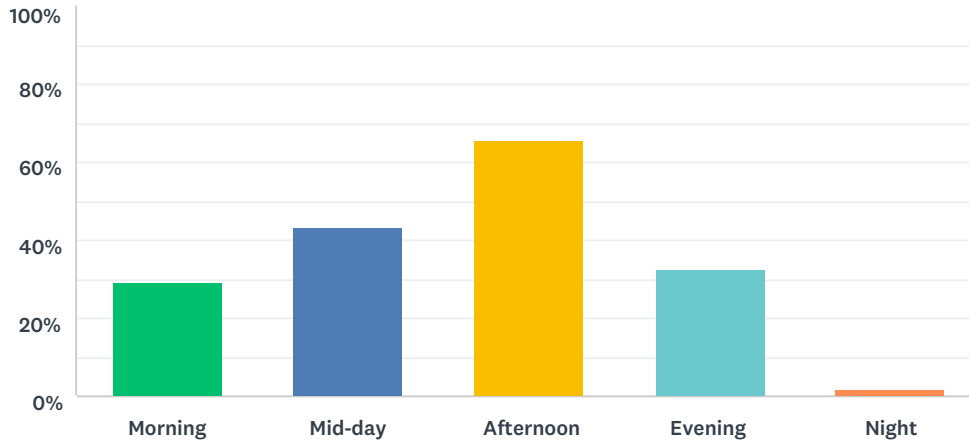

Q7 What time of day are you usually at the park? (check all that apply)

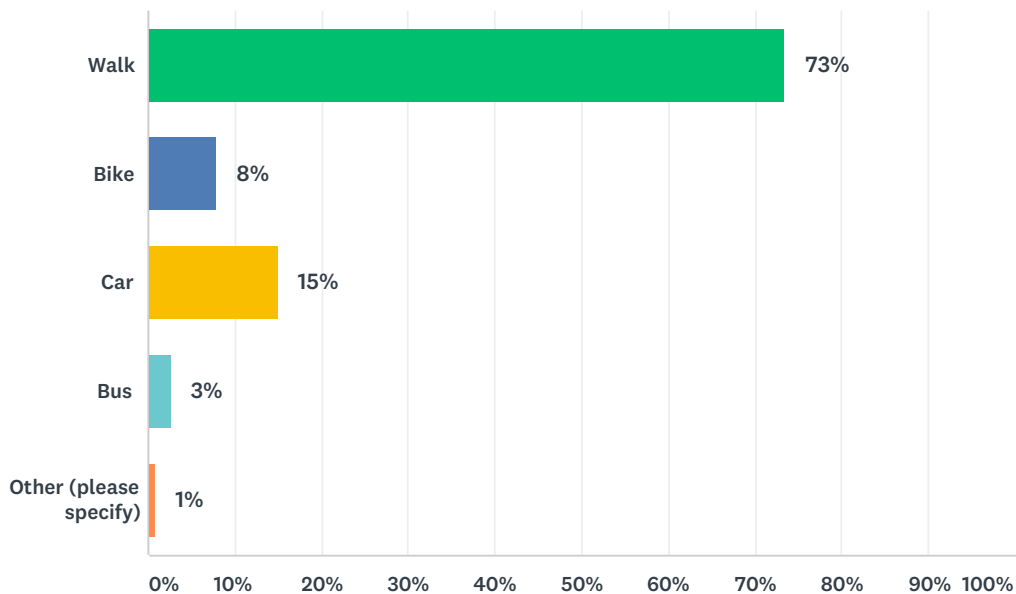
