The meeting was called to order at 7:35p.

- 1. Introductions: Prospective members Heidi Kendig and Elisa Hupp were introduced, as was guest ACAC Co-Chair Stephanie Marlin-Curiel.
- 2. Selection of minutes recorder: Lisbet was designated as notetaker.
- 3. July 9th Meeting Minutes were approved unanimously.
- 4. Treasurer's Report: Outstanding Grant Agreements and W-9 forms: still needed from Claudia Donnet and Arlington Public Art.
 - It was noted that Treasurer's files are missing from Dropbox. Jeff has backups and will address this when he returns from vacation.
- 5. Corresponding Secretary/Grantee Status Report:
 - Arlington Center for the Arts "Migration" project will probably now happen in November/December.
 - Magnolia Park 2 bigger structures done, 3rd to be done.
 - Heather (Dallin Museum): A projected October opening.
 - Dan Fox final report? Liaison Jeff is on vacation, so will check.
 - Talking Chair Kimberley w/check on final report.

ACTION ITEM: Liaisons should follow up with their grantees for final reports, updates, etc.

- 6. Updating grant guidelines for 2019 grant cycle: The process was explained to our two guests.
 - Poet Laureate Cathie Desjardins has emailed the Co-Chairs for suggestions on how to frame a proposal.

Criteria for Proposals: D. should have a letter of commitment from the venue "show evidence of acknowledged contact with the proposed venue"

G. "it will typically not fund the same project for more than 3 consecutive years."

"Open to the broadest possible range of Arlington residents": Delete "broadest". Becky will send Lisbet the language.

- 7. Upcoming Events: Town Day: Promotional materials needed. No action items were determined.
- 8. Merger with ACAC: Since Stephanie M.-C. was absent at the August 2nd ACAC meeting with MCC's Arreen Andrew, it was explained to her that:
 - ACC cannot administer any Town funds unless they are added to ACC's funds and follow MCC guidelines.
 - Nor can it award grant funds to any ACAC voting member organization.
 - ACC must be a non-voting member of ACAC.
 - -As Arreen suggested we try this arrangement out for one year, it was decided that ACC will retain its name in the interim, as the start of the new grant cycle begins September 1; that is how we are known in Town among the grantee community; we wouldn't want to change ACC's name and then have to change it back in one year (as Arreen has indicated most other LCCs have done in similar circumstances).
 - ACTION ITEM: Lisbet will send info to Amy Mongeau for ArtsArlington.org: past grantees; current grantees; guidelines; Join Us; photos.
- 9. ArtsArlington.org is now up. Grantees should be encouraged to post their events on the site, which goes directly to ArtsBoston, that screens the entries. Arlington events will automatically populate the ArtsArlington.org Calendar site.
- 10. Basecamp (\$99/month): Stephanie M.C., in looking to organize ACAC subgroups, needs to find an online program. After discussing Basecamp's merits, it was deemed too pricy, reviews were fair to middlin', and it was popular only in the past. She is on the search for something cheaper. Kimberley: Does Town already have something onto which ACAC can add itself? Organizational problems because people need to be updated at general meeting, which wastes time. Microsoft Onenote: one possibility, very user-friendly, but clumsier. "Asana." "Lifehacker." Becky: Do you still have your data when you leave the platform? Kimberley: Does use violate Open Meeting Law?: Stephanie forwarded a query to Doug Heim (Town Counsel). Basecamp or any such program is really for committee work. Heidi offered several suggestions to Stephanie for programs to check.
- 11. Heidi Kendig is interested in joining the Council. Since the due date of her child is September 13, ACC will hold her application until she indicates when she is prepared to join.
