# SPECIFICATIONS FOR PLUMBING MAINTENANCE SERVICE CONRACT AT VARIOUS TOWN AND SCHOOL BUILDINGS

### **GENERAL RIQUIREMENTS**

The Contractor shall use trained personnel to perform the labor for the required services. These workmen must have appropriate licenses. A list of qualified workman and their credentials must be supplied with the original bid to the Town of Arlington. No Sub-Contractors are allowed with this bid.

The Contractor, or his representative, shall report to the Superintendent of Facilities for each day that work is being performed on site. A work report shall be submitted daily with the following information listed below. It is preferable if the report is sent electronically to the Superintendent of Facilities on a daily basis.

- a) Dates
- b) Time of start and finish of each job
- c) Brief description of work being performed
- d) Name and number of parts repaired or replaced
- e) Recommendations or comments pertaining to the work.
- f) Hours worked

The contractor shall render <u>priority service</u> to the Town of Arlington to perform all emergency and ordinary service as a condition of this Contract. If, for any reason, any shut down for an extended period is required, the Superintendent of Facilities shall be notified immediately of the problem, and the measures being taken to restore the service as soon as possible.

As work is scheduled, the Contractor shall issue to the mechanic on the job; the necessary and appropriate manufacturers recommended maintenance procedures, and a listing of the apparatus concerned.

All <u>planned</u> repairs under these specifications shall be performed during normal working hours of a regular business day, which is typically between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Monday thru Friday. Planned repairs will be completed at a straight time hourly rate.

Emergency corrective maintenance service, including overtime service, shall be included under this Contract, on a "time and material basis" as needed. Service of this nature, that may be needed in order to keep the building systems in proper operating condition, shall be provided within twenty four (24) hours from the time such call originates (including weekends and holidays). Emergency repairs shall be provided a on a twenty four hour (24), seven (7) day a week basis.

After-hour telephone calls for emergency repairs shall be answered directly to the Contractor's personal or answering service.

July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020 July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021 July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022
Term of Contract- This service shall commence on the first day of this contract and continue for a period of one (1) year, two (2) years or three (3) years as indicated. The option of extending the contract for years two and three are within the sole discretion of the Town of Arlington.
The Contractor is to further guarantee that the labor and material will be up to the standard and suitable for the various purposes intended.
The Town of Arlington reserves the right to obtain competitive quotes on all projects and will bid all projects in excess of \$10,000.00

#### **REQUIREMENTS**

• Bidder must provide a bid surety in the form of certified check, money order, or bid bond payable to Town of Arlington in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the bid total amount.

The successful bidder shall be fully licensed to do business as a registered contractor in the state of Massachusetts and have full-time Massachusetts Licensed PLUMBING journeymen servicemen on staff. Only CORI, SORI and Finger Print approved employees are allowed to work under this contract. Any personnel who fail the CORI or SORI or Finger Prints application will not be allowed to work under this contract. Contractor shall provide a written certification that all employees are legally authorized to work in the United States.

- 1. Insurance
- 2. CORI, SORI and Finger print documents working under this contract.
- 3. Applicable OSHA certifications.

- The wage schedule shall be incorporated in any advertisement or call for bids for the project as required by M.G.L. c. 149, § 27. The wage schedule shall be made a part of the contract awarded for the project. The wage schedule must be posted in a conspicuous place at the work site for the life of the project in accordance with M.G.L. c. 149 § 27. The wages listed on the wage schedule must be paid to employees performing construction work on the project whether they are employed by the prime contractor, a filed sub-bidder, or any sub-contractor.
- All apprentices working on the project are required to be registered with the Massachusetts Department of Labor Standards, Division of Apprentice Standards (DLS/DAS). Apprentice must keep his/her apprentice identification card on his/her person during all work hours on the project. An apprentice registered with DAS may be paid the lower apprentice wage rate at the applicable step as provided on the prevailing wage schedule. Any apprentice not registered with DLS/DAS regardless of whether or not they are registered with any other federal, state, local, or private agency must be paid the journeyworker's rate for the trade.
- The wage rates will remain in effect for the duration of the project, except in the case of multi-year public construction projects. For construction projects lasting longer than one year, awarding authorities must request an updated wage schedule. Awarding authorities are required to request these updates no later than two weeks before the anniversary of the date the contract was executed by the awarding authority and the general contractor. For multi-year CM AT RISK projects, awarding authority must request an annual update no later than two weeks before the anniversary date, determined as the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the execution date of the first amendment to permit procurement of construction services. Contractors are required to obtain the wage schedules from awarding authorities, and to pay no less than these rates to covered workers. The annual update requirement is not applicable to 27F "rental of equipment" contracts.
- Every contractor or subcontractor which performs construction work on the project is required to submit weekly payroll reports and a Statement of Compliance directly to the awarding authority by mail or email and keep them on file for three years. Each weekly payroll report must contain: the employee's name, address, occupational classification, hours worked, and wages paid. Do not submit weekly payroll reports to DLS. - Failure of a contractor or subcontractor to pay the prevailing wage rates listed on the wage schedule to all employees who perform construction work on the project is a violation of the law and subjects the contractor or subcontractor to civil and
