Minutes

1. Introductions. The meeting started with quick introductions since we had a new visitor.

- 2. Juli and Priya provided a quick recap of Town Meeting and the articles that passed.
- 3. Juli provided additional details on Article 29
 - a. Ali Carter (Economic Development) to help with contacting businesses about ban. We need to coordinate with Christine and Natasha at the Health Dept - Juli. Jim said he will reach out to thank them for their support. Look at their forms.
 - b. Do they want us to go out to the restaurants we'll need to mobilize for that. Ali Carter can help with that.
 - c. Strategically start thinking about plastic straws, single use plastics could this be a second wave.
 - d. We could put together a flyer that makes some suggestions for best practices.
 - e. There was a suggestion of getting a stamp of approval for restaurants to put on their windows from the committee e.g. on the path to zero waste.
 - f. We can do something to highlight a business business of the year cited for their recycling practices. Za and Kickstand?
 - g. Beth from the Chamber of Commerce also is on the (?)
- 4. Recycling Coordinators Report
 - a. The trash tonnage is quite flat no significant change
 - b. Recycling unreliable measure since packaging is changing all the time so weight cannot be looked at
 - c. Trash can be looked at we are doing better than a lot of communities

- d. Contamination potentially hiring a consultancy (for audit) for negotiating contract. This will come with a price. If we have good practices might not need the audit
- e. Support from the state is available. DEP providing technical support, forward policies; we don't have a paint stewardship program so you can drop off the paint so state can put back into reuse.
- f. Marketing tools available to us
- g. There are some changes coming to the Recycling Guide standard across the neighboring communities standard graphics. Cartons are out.
- h. We need to sign the contract with someone for logo designer
- i. Fixit clinics and repair cafes. Fix it clinic you do the fixing; Repair Cafe you drop your item off and it will be fixed. We are going with the Fix It clinic.
- j. We need enthusiastic coaches recruited. July 14 is the first clinic. We need coaches for general fixers (small appliances, bikes, hems, seams, chair, jewellery). It will be a 3 hour event at the Thompson School Gym. Next one November 2. We can do the marketing we need a promotions person. We have posters and logo. Food and music?
- 5. Event Planning Feast of the East
 - a. Tables near the Arts Arl table Cecily wants to do collaboratively with us
 - b. Run the puppet create a sign for ZWA for the puppet to get our name out.
 - c. Pick a workshop and Charlotte would like to create the signage anyone wants to help her can join.
 - d. Create a sign up genius for volunteers
 - e. Larry will register for the table
 - f. Our usual tabling we'll bring something to sell; blue barrels and tote bags
 - g. We need a hand out and promote Fix It Clinic. Priya will help Juli handouts to explain our mission etc.
- 6. Last hour of the meeting was given to True Story Theater who worked with the committee on various themes that members came up with.
