Minutes

- 1. ZWA is now using the projector and a laptop in the Town Hall Annex meeting room. No paper for printing out minutes and agendas will be used!
- 2. May minutes approved
- 3. Feast of the East Larry provided the committee with an update on the event with Allison and Priya adding in some comments
 - a. There were a lot of questions about composting
 - b. There was a lot of enthusiasm and questions
 - c. Charlotte spoke about the Town adding a search module on the website where we could guide people to look for how they can recycle items
 - d. There was a discussion about the materials we had prepared. It was very windy hard to keep everything down; the composting information quarters were very handy
- 4. Fix It Clinic July 14
 - a. We need to promote the clinic we could connect to the other clinics on FB
 - Some articles have been written about it on Recycling page (Town website)
 - c. The November clinic will have clothing swap as well
 - d. A lot of the logistics have been worked out by Charlotte
- 5. New Name this is an intermediate period between switching names from Recycling Committee to Zero Waste Arlington and we will need to use both for a few months
- 6. Beer Garden Tabling
 - a. Sarah will set up a Sign Up Genius (1, 2, 2 volunteers for 3 shifts). More volunteers to help with the event composting
 - b. More compost guides (verbally direct people to FIDO but they need to register on the website)

- c. There is capacity for anaerobic digestion (lesser for composting)
- d. Some suggestions on getting the message out about composting we should ask Aeronaut staff to promote; announce from the stage; put a cup on compost can and some image of the cup on the sign. Keep experimenting
- e. Maybe use it as an opportunity to recruit volunteers
- f. We should have gloves available for volunteers and garbage grabbers (Charlotte will provide)
- g. Larry will find out about who is taking the compost
- h. We should consider getting a smaller tent for these events
- i. Allison will summarize and communicate with Aeronaut
- 7. Town Day we are registered as Zero Waste Arlington
 - a. We could try and get on the Town Day Committee?
 - b. The table can have 3 bins for people to use
 - c. Try composting today sign on a bin on the table
- 8. Rebranding transition
 - a. Budget allocated approx \$1500
 - b. We reached out to 2 designers and one of them has worked with Envision Arlington and have picked her (Sarah Mascarelli)
 - c. Sarah will be point person should have contract signed in a couple days.
 - d. We should have process wrapped up by August
- 9. Recycling Coordinator Update
 - a. Recycling Guide is almost done
 - b. Recycling Dept and intern did some outreach on the styrofoam ban with small businesses.
 - c. Tours were successful good turn out. These are good people to ask to volunteer. Paul and Rich spoke about the experience Deer Island is very large; processing over a billion gallons; tour was very technical
- 10. ZWA Leadership discussion Larry spoke about the process. If members want to step up to a leadership position they can think about it and we can vote in July meeting.
- 11. Paul brought up a suggestion of engaging legislators and other organizations in Town and other towns as another initiative we could take up
