

Bulky Waste - How to dispose of it in Arlington

*** Acceptable items only, others may require private disposal * Limit one bulky trash item per household, per week ***
*** Place out on the curb by 7 AM on your regular collection day * Call JRM for \$20 appliance disposal at 800-323-4285 ***

Item	Trash?	Details	Examples
Furniture and built-in furniture	Yes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leave furniture in one piece • <u>Strictly</u> one piece per week <p>IMPORTANT: Dismantled furniture looks like scrap wood and reveals nails and splintered wood.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chair, table, sofa, bench, desk, table, bed, futon frame, book case • Mattress/box spring set • Toilet, sink • Microwave oven or toaster
Construction & demolition material	No	State laws prohibits these materials:	NO asphalt, brick, concrete, stone, wallboard, large appliances
Large metal item	Some yes, Some no	<p>YES: Grill, lawnmower (fluids removed)</p> <p>MAYBE: bed frame -call JRM to confirm size, no charge for these</p> <p>NO: Exercise equipment, freestanding basketball hoops, file cabinets, snow blower- These may require private pay</p>	
Log or branch over 1" in diameter	No	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give them to someone with a fireplace • Dispose with private landscaping service • Sticks 1" in diameter and under must be placed out with yard waste 	
Tire and auto part	No	• Private disposal only, check with your auto mechanic for tire recycling	
DIY material	Small amounts	<p>YES: 4' wide and tall piece of fence, a door, a window, a few shingles or tiles in a trash barrel, one room of carpet cut to 3' lengths then rolled and tied/taped, little bits of insulation.</p> <p>NO contractor bags of heavy materials we cannot see and monitor.</p>	
Milled wood	Some	• See the <i>Bulky Wood Waste Guide</i> for details	



These are too long

Cut to 4' or under, place in a barrel, cannot weigh over 50 lbs.



Cut longer fence piece to 4' high by 4' long
