## **Geothermal Design Proposal Review**

- Group discussed the McPhail Geothermal Design Proposal.
- Skanska clarifies that the geothermal wells are being proposed around the perimeter of building, not inside the building.
- Sandy expresses concern that McPhail may not be experienced enough to perform 400 wells.
  This is one of the largest well geothermal wells installation projects not only in the state, but nationally.
- Kate expressed that we will need to understand the operational cost and maintenance cost of the wells for the town and district.
- Jim to check with Lori on the timing of the life-cycle cost analysis.
- Sandy asks when Consigli will be able to provide input on the geothermal well design.
  - Jim we need to get to a design before they can truly give recommendations.
- Sandy Pooler moved to approve the proposal. Kate Loosian seconded the motion. Vote passed unanimously.
- Brian requests a memo on the workflow and decision process for the geothermal design. Kate would like it to include a summary of critical steps.

## Value Management Process Review
