#### **CONTRACT SPECIFICATIONS FOR ELEVATOR MAINTENANCE**

The work to be performed under this specification shall include the furnishing of all labor, materials, equipment and supervision necessary for the servicing of all elevators/handicap lifts and related equipment in all buildings operated by the Town of Arlington for a period of three (3) fiscal years from the date of contract. The contractor is requested to quote an hourly labor rate for services. All repair work will be on an as needed basis.

#### **INTENT OF CONTRACT**

The intent of this contract is for the contractor to provide quarterly inspections of all Town elevators and chairlifts to insure that all mechanical, electrical and safety systems are operating within manufacturer's specifications. Such inspections shall also include lubrications and adjustments as specified by the manufacturer, and identification of repairs that will require additional work. The contract shall also reflect a fixed annual cost for testing and permitting each elevator or lift as required by state regulations.

In addition the contract shall include a fixed hourly rate for labor for all repairs requested by the Town as a result of the identification of repairs made by the contractor during quarterly inspections, or identification of repairs made by the Contractor or the Town at times other than the quarterly inspections, including service outages. Also, the contract shall include a fixed mark-up for materials and supplies above cost.

#### **ELEVATOR/LIFT LOCATIONS**

The contractor should visit each site to verify the information and become familiar with the equipment prior to bidding.

#### **GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

All work shall comply in every respect with the Building Laws, Town Regulations, Code Requirements (either city, state or national) and the requirements of the Massachusetts Department of Public Safety.

The contractor shall obtain and pay for all permits, licenses, etc., as may be necessary or required for the completion of the work.

All equipment, materials, etc., specified to be removed from the site shall become the property of the contractor, unless otherwise stated.

All repair work will be left in a safe and workable condition.

Contractor shall **ONLY** repair what he is instructed to repair.

If there are any questions regarding the repair work that is to be done, it will be the responsibility of the contractor to contact the Facilities Director or their designee before proceeding.

No single job that would cost more than \$1,000.00 shall be started without the consent of the Facilities Director of their designee before proceeding.

No single job shall exceed \$5,000.00 under the terms of this contract.

It will be required that the contractor diagnose the problem and make the necessary repairs as soon as possible.

The contractor must work as quickly and efficiently as is possible. All repairs are to be professional quality.

The awarding authority reserves the right to terminate the contract at once if it appears that any job is not being performed as expeditiously as possible.

By executing this contract, the contractor represents that he has familiarized himself with the local conditions under which the work is to be performed.

In the event of accidental site damage, it will be the responsibility of the contractor to return the site to its original condition at no cost to the Town of Arlington.

If temporary repairs are needed due to an emergency, the contractor is instructed to do so at the direction of the Facilities Director or their designee.

All permanent repairs must be made as soon as is possible. This must be done at a minimum within five (5) days after the problem has been diagnosed and approval to proceed has been given.

It will be the responsibility of the contractor to leave the area in a clean, "broom swept" condition, and must remove all debris generated while making repairs.

#### **DESCRIPTION OF WORK**

This contract will include the regular systematic inspection, maintenance and repair of all elevators/chairlifts operated by the Town of Arlington. Emergency and non-emergency related repairs will be on an as needed basis. There will be four (4) scheduled calls per elevator per year. The contractor shall also contact the Department of Public Safety-Division of Inspection to schedule the state inspection of the elevators, and complete any necessary application(s), pre-inspection checklist(s) or related forms.

The elevators will be inspected, cleaned, oil/greased, adjusted etc., four (4) times a year. The inspection will include but is not limited to:

- Overall inspection of equipment per checklist
- Minor parts such as nuts, bolts, screws, washers, pins, clamps
- Any miscellaneous lubrication products such as grease, oil, etc. (hydraulic oil will be billed separately)

#### **INSPECTION CHECKLIST**

The checklist will include but is not limited to:

- Check all operations of elevator
- Clean out the pit, remove all debris from pit
- Clean and oil machine motor, interlocks and controller
- Adjust and lubricate all working parts including guides
- Check to make sure elevator stops at each floor safely and correctly
- Check all controls (call buttons/switches) at each floor
- Test all safety devices and governors
- Check tension of all hoisting cables and equalize
- · Renew guide shoe gibs as necessary
- Any other regularly accepted industry practices

Any necessary repairs to be completed at time of inspection shall be done on a time and materials basis following consent of the Facilities Director or their designee. The contractor shall prepare a written proposal for any further repairs and submit this to the Facilities Director or their designee for review within five (5) business days of the inspection. See section pertaining to proposals.

The inspection must take place during the following period only.

First Inspection FIRST 15 DAYS IN JULY
Second Inspection FIRST 15 DAYS IN OCTOBER
Third Inspection FIRST 15 DAYS IN JANUARY
Fourth Inspection FIRST 15 DAYS IN APRIL

The inspections must be done between 7:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M.

#### **STATE INSPECTIONS**

The contractor shall schedule with the State Elevator Inspector an inspection of each elevator as required by law. The contractor shall include in the bid price the state inspection fee. The inspection fee will be the flat fee specified on the bid form, inclusive of both the necessary contractor labor and state fee. The contractor cannot charge the Town of Arlington for any time traveling to and from the site, or for any sundries or vehicle charges. The contractor shall receive a copy of the inspector's report and attach it with the service slip to the invoice for the work performed, a duplicate copy of inspector's report must be submitted to the Facilities Director or their designee. In the event an elevator or lift does not pass inspection, the contractor shall provide a written proposal within five (5) business days of the inspection for any work that is needed in order to pass inspection and receive a certificate. The contractor cannot charge the Town of Arlington for any weights that may be needed in order to test the elevator for the inspector.

#### MATERIALS/SUPPLIES

It will be the requirement of the contractor to provide all the tools and equipment needed to do the job. The worker must bring the proper and basic tools and supplies as is applicable with him when he first visits the site. The Town of Arlington shall not be charged for the use of the equipment that the contractor may need to complete a job. The Town of Arlington shall not be responsible for any of the worker's equipment that is lost, stolen or damaged.

The contractor may use the site's existing services if they are available in order to complete a job. This would include water and electricity. This may be withdrawn if it is determined by the Town that the contractor is abusing the privilege. The contractor may be charged for the use of the services if it is determined that the contractor is abusing the privilege.

#### **COMPLETED WORK**

All work completed and tested. It must be left in full operating order. It must be left in a safe condition where no harm can come to any person because of a lack of ordinary care. It will be the responsibility of the worker to test the operation of the equipment/repair or prove the work was successfully completed in the presence of the the Facilities Department Representative. This must be noted on the order/service slip. The Facilities Department Representative will sign the slip.

#### **CORRECTIONS TO WORK**

If the Town of Arlington, at its sole discretion, feels that the work performed by the vendor is not adequate, then the Town of Arlington will notify the vendor on this in writing. The vendor will have five (5) business days to respond and make the necessary corrections. If the vendor fails to do this, then this will be grounds for cancellation of this contract. The Town of Arlington may remedy the problem by hiring an outside vendor to complete/correct the job. The contracting vendor may be charged for these corrective

services. If the contractor fails to correct defective work or persistently fails to carry out the work in accordance with the contract documents, the Town of Arlington will cause this contract to be cancelled.

#### **WARRANTIES/GUARANTEES**

All labor shall be guaranteed for a period of time not less than one (1) year. There shall be a warranty for all materials used. This warranty shall be a manufacturer's warranty. If a part fails within the manufacturer's warranty time frame, then it will be up to the vendor to replace this part free of charge.

#### **PROPOSALS**

It will be required that from time to time the contractor provide the Town of Arlington with a proposal to perform work. The site must be visited. The proposal shall contain:

- Name and location of building
- Total cost (labor & materials)
- Breakdown of costs (labor-# of men, # of hours/materials-types & amounts)
- Special equipment needed
- Other special conditions
- Specify exactly what work is to be done
- Number of days to complete job
- Number of days needed to start job after receiving authorization

If the proposal is accepted, the work shall be done on time and the materials not to exceed the quoted price. Actual service slips must be made available upon request of the Facilities Director of their designee.

#### **SERVICE SLIPS**

It will be required that every time a serviceman enters a building to do work, a service slip/work order must be filled out describing the work. The slip must include but is not limited to the following information:

Company's Name Address Telephone # Worker's Complete Name

Specify exactly what work was performed. Give details about the unit and its related characteristics as is possible.

Specify exactly where the work was performed in the school or building. Give panel numbers or room number as is appropriate.

Specify any and all materials that were used and the amounts that were used. Also, specify the manufacturer, type, model number and any other pertinent information about the material(s) used.

Specify the cause of the failure in the first place. Note any outstanding items/problems that still exist.

Specify the starting time and the completion time of the work that was performed. Also, the date on which it was completed.

Specify the exact number of hours/minutes the contractor was on the site while working on the problem.

Specify the worker plans on returning to complete the work by the next day(s), week.

Specify as a suggestion any extra work that may be needed in the near future to insure proper operation or maintenance.

It will be required that this slip be signed by and left with the Facilities Department Representative. No other person's signature will be accepted. A copy of this slip shall also accompany the invoice.

#### **INVOICES**

No invoice will be paid without the proper information attached. It will be required that all invoices be prepared in the following manner:

All invoices must be original.

The copy of the service slip must accompany the invoice.

The Town of Arlington can only be invoiced after all the work has been completed.

All pertinent information must be on the invoice.

- Number of hours worked (Multiply this by the hourly rate)
- Any and all materials used for the job with their individual prices
- Brief description of work that was done

If the contracting vendor uses materials or services from an outside vendor, the invoice must state the cost for those items to the contracting vendor plus no more than the quoted profit percent amount. If the contractor quotes a percent off discount price, the invoice must state the list price with the discount price that will be charged to the city.

It must be dated properly and accurately.

If work is completed to the dissatisfaction of the Town of Arlington, it will be held up for payment. When the problem is corrected, then the invoice will be processed.

All invoices must be sent to the designated department.

The contractor cannot charge the Town of Arlington for any time traveling to and from the site, or for any sundries or vehicle charges.

#### OVERCHARGING (MATERIALS)

If the Town of Arlington has any questions as to the validity of an invoice, the Department will notify the vendor of this in writing. The vendor will have five (5) business days to answer any and all questions and to proof of such items as:

(for materials/outside services)

Copy of invoice stating the amount that the vendor was charged for supplies/services etc. Invoice must be a legitimate copy to be forwarded to the Facilities Department.

The invoice must be dated.

The invoice must have the company's name, address and telephone number along with a contact person's name.

Proof that the invoice was paid by the Contractor.

The Purchasing Department, at the time of bid opening, requests information regarding percent of discount price of materials. The Town of Arlington may request from the contracting vendor a copy of any list prices from the company with which the vendor conducts his business for materials. The purpose of this is to confirm the contractor's cost to the Town.

#### **HOURLY RATE**

Under the terms of this contract, the perspective vendor must quote a regular labor rate per hour for any work done between 7:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. Monday thru Friday. No job will have more than one (1) man working at a time unless explicit permission is received by the department. If the contractor sends more than one (1) man, it will be at his own discretion and cost.

#### **MILEAGE**

The Town of Arlington cannot be charged for any time, mileage fees or other costs while a tradesman is traveling to and from the site. The vendor shall take into account this cost in his hourly rate when he bids. Time begins when the tradesman arrives at the site and ends when he leaves the site.

An apprentice registered with DAS may be paid the lower apprentice wage rate at the applicable step as provided on the prevailing wage schedule. Any apprentice not registered with DLS/DAS regardless of whether or not they are registered with any other federal, state, local, or private agency must be paid the journeyworker's rate for the trade.
- The wage rates will remain in effect for the duration of the project, except in the case of multi-year public construction projects. For construction projects lasting longer than one year, awarding authorities must request an updated wage schedule. Awarding authorities are required to request these updates no later than two weeks before the anniversary of the date the contract was executed by the awarding authority and the general contractor. For multi-year CM AT RISK projects, awarding authority must request an annual update no later than two weeks before the anniversary date, determined as the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the execution date of the first amendment to permit procurement of construction services. Contractors are required to obtain the wage schedules from awarding authorities, and to pay no less than these rates to covered workers. The annual update requirement is not applicable to 27F "rental of equipment" contracts.
- Every contractor or subcontractor which performs construction work on the project is required to submit weekly payroll reports and a Statement of Compliance directly to the awarding authority by mail or email and keep them on file for three years. Each weekly payroll report must contain: the employee's name, address, occupational classification, hours worked, and wages paid. Do not submit weekly payroll reports to DLS.
