






#### **Stratton Elementary Area**

As of 2019, Stratton Elementary School had 462 students.


During the 2019 school year:


- 60% of students walked to school
- 49% of students walked from school




### **Project Goals**

- Remove accessibility barriers by installing ADA-compliant curb ramps and repairing deficient sidewalks;
- Install new sidewalks to provide a safe and accessible walking path to and around the Stratton school;
- Narrow roadway intersections to slow vehicles and reduce pedestrian crossing distances;
- Provide safe pedestrian crossings at intersections where needed; and
- Install appropriate signage through the project corridor.







# REVISED SCOPE











#### Current Design -

All proposed elements within existing roadway right of way (ROW)

Seeks to maintain/mimic grass buffer along Hemlock

Prioritizes contiguous yard over buffer along Dickson/Mountain

Potential impact to Utility Poles along Mountain and Dickson

Impacts to trees along Hemlock, Dickson and Mountain for ADA







#### **Potential Trade-offs – Mountain Avenue**






#### **Potential Trade-offs – Dickson Avenue**




