




- Over 1,650 responses to the Bikeway survey

- Project must be completed by June 30, 2022




# Data Update: Swan Place Eco Counter and Bluebikes



## Bikeway at Swan Place Data

- Total trips YTD: 516,453 (+38,051 since last month)
- Bike Trips YTD: 278,889 (+21,087 since last month)
  - 39,268 trips in May
  - 41,491 in June
  - 37,127 in July
  - 38,097 in August
  - 39,937 in September
  - 31,669 in October
  - 27,318 in November so far
- Highest trip day in last 30 days:
   Sun. October 17 3,010 trips



## **Arlington Bluebikes Data**

#### Trip Data:

- 9,062 trips year-to-date in2021
  - (+ 847 from last month)
- 1,057 trips in May
- 1,162 in June
- 1,223 in July
- 1,342 in August
- 1,576 in September
- 1,271 in October
- 429 so far in November






## **Arlington Bluebikes Data**

## Bluebikes Winter Operations


- Off-street stations to be picked up around Thanksgiving (week of Nov. 22), redeployment in April
- Winter storage is an additional fee the Town pays (\$2,500 per station)
- Off-street locations can operate yearround and avoid storage fee

## Bluebikes Stations Off-Street Relocations

- Railroad Lot @ Bikeway to be moved to brick sidewalk behind 633-641 Mass Ave
  - Approved by Select Board but trying to make modifications to location based on abutter feedback
- Linwood St @ Bikeway relocation to new sidewalk built by DPW behind existing sidewalk
- Relocations to occur when other stations are put into storage
