RECAP OF RETREAT

Wonderful ideas were presented at the retreat

- -Literary Snippet Window Project & Transformer Box
- -For this to happen, few things we "need to know" before moving forward are:

Permission, from town & businesses to place snippets on windows along Mass Ave

- Create a subcommittee/standing committee that would have liaisons with storeowners, writers and graphics (signage person)
- Issues with this project -sizing may interfere with town bylaws (Bill will take on Sign Bylaw part to find out if will be a problem

- Transformer Boxes- need to talk to Town, DPW, NStar and find out what approvals are needed to get it
 done
- Dave proposed if Arlington HS is first transformer box project, students could possibly do a collaboration with Winfred Rembert (well known artist known for his art on tooled & hand painted leather)
- Money raised from Chairful can be used to help fund these projects
- February meeting would be good to make a decision if Literary Snippet & Transformer Box project are what we want for 2014
