## NOTICE REGARDING TOWN MEETING RESULTS

We have outstanding provisional ballots to resolve, but I can confirm some details for the candidates today. The <u>unofficial results</u> are sorted in the order of votes and this quick summary will explain how to read the results and what still needs to be resolved.

The recent change to the Town Manager Act (Section 8b) states that a tie that would affect which term the candidates serve is determined by a meeting of all the elected Town Meeting Members from the precinct, including the two who tied. The Town Clerk will notify all the members of each precinct where this applies within the next two days.

Precinct 1:	top 4 for 3-year seats, last person for a 1-year seat
Precinct 2:	three people on the ballot elected for 3-year seats
	a write in candidate was elected a for 3-year seat, pending acceptance

Precinct 3: top 3 elected for 3-year seats

Tie vote for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> place means a precinct meeting will decide the terms the winners serve (1 for 3 years and 1 for 1 year)

Precinct 4: 4 people elected for 3-year seats

Precinct 5: top 4 for 3-year seats, next 4 for 2-year seats, next three elected for 1 year and

a write in candidate was elected for 1 year, pending acceptance

Precinct 6: top 4 elected for 3-year seats

Precinct 7: top 4 for 3-year seats, next 4 for 2-year seats, 4 people need to be elected as write-in

candidates or appointed by the other elected members from the precinct for 1 year terms. 3 people elected, pending acceptance. At least one person will need to be

appointed.

Precinct 8: top 4 for 3-year seats, next 4 for 2-year seats, last 4 for 1-year seats

Precinct 9: top 4 for 3-year seats, next 4 for 2-year seats, 4 write-in candidates elected, pending

acceptance. If any decline the seat will be appointed by the other Town Meeting

Members in that precinct.

Precinct 10: top 4 for 3-year seats, next 4 for 2-year seats, last 4 for 1-year seats

Precinct 11: Write in votes have changed the order of the 2-year and 3-year term winners

Precinct 12: top 4 for 3-year seats, next person elected for a 2-year seat

Precinct 13: top 4 for 3-year seats, next 4 for 2-year seats, last 4 for 1-year seats

Precinct 14: top 4 for 3-year seats, next person for 2-year seat, last person for 1-year seat

Precinct 15: top 4 for 3-year seats, next 4 for 2-year seats, last 4 for 1-year seats Precinct 16: top 4 for 3-year seats, next 4 for 2-year seats, last 4 for 1-year seats Precinct 17: top 3 elected for 3-year seats; tie vote for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> place means a precinct meeting will decide the terms the winners serve (1 for 3 years and 1 for 2 years)

1 person elected for a 1-year seat, 2 write in candidates must accept 1-year seats and a meeting of the members will be needed to elect at least 1 person for a 1-year term

Precinct 18: top 4 for 3-year seats, next 4 for 2-year seats, last 4 for 1-year seats

Precinct 19: 3 candidates on the ballot elected for 3-year seats

A write in candidate received enough votes to be elected for the 4<sup>th</sup> 3-year seat A write in candidate received enough votes to be elected for a 1-year seat

Precinct 20: 4 people elected for 3-year seats

Precinct 21: top 3 elected for 3-year seats

Tie vote for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> place means a precinct meeting will decide the terms the winners

serve (1 for 3 years and 1 for 1 year)
