

CONSTRUCTION 4 WEEK SCHEDULE – STARTING WEEK OF OCTOBER 3RD, 2022

The above layout identifies demolition areas in the work site and impacts along Grove Street. Additional work to be performed in the upcoming weeks includes:

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES:

- Building E Complete Roofing and Exterior Framing & Sheathing
- Building E Continue MEP & FP Rough Work Inside Building
- Building E Continue 1st Floor Framing, 2nd Floor is Complete
- Building E Installation of Hollow Metal Door Frames/Openings Ongoing
- Building E Continue to Erect Steel/Decking at Mezzanine and Roofing Premanufactured Structural Steel Maintenance Building
- Sitework Continue Install of New Retaining Wall, Fuel Island, Storm Water Detention System
- Sitework Underground Utilities From the Street to the Building Continues

PUBLIC IMPACTS:

- Jersey Barriers will be used to direct traffic along Grove Street
- During sitework, trucks will be entering and leaving the site regularly

CONSTRUCTION DETAILS

Phase 1 shall include complete demolition of existing structures as shown, and construction of Building A, Building E, the new connector b/w Buildings A & B, the new Salt Shed, and the new Fuel Island. Also included is the emergency generator, associated utilities, underground electrical duct banks b/w Buildings A, B, C, D, E; the new transformer.

CONSTRUCTION SAFTEY

The health and safety of the community and workers on-site are of the highest priority. There will be continuous air monitoring and dust control in place with misters. Commodore safety department will undertake regular safety visits

COVID-19 UPDATE

There will be daily check-ins for COVID and all state and federal guidelines will be followed.




