Consigli Update

John LaMarre reported out on the following:

- PH-1 Bldg. D &E punch list, Currently (17) open items we need to complete, (27) Ready for Review, and (2,938) Closed. To be completed by end of year
- Bldg. B steel erection continued through November, Bldg. C erection set to begin in early December. Concrete slab on decks resumed through November, and first structural slab on grade placement first week of December. Overall steel erection is impacted weather days incurred in November.
- As of 12/1/22 Schedule Update, Phase 2 turnover is (9) days behind the scheduled turn over date. Consigli continues to review the current work and future activities for mitigation and recovery.

- Owner design decisions required for Phase 2 + 3 Super Graphics & Signage for formal issuance of design files in order to produce submittals and procure/release long lead materials for phase 2. Submittal reviews required for release/procurement of electrical materials.
- PH-2 materials. Inventory of materials in storage and all materials that can be released into production continues so as to reduce the potential for supply chain impacts.
- Phase 3 & 4 schedule modifications. Revised schedule dated 12/1/22 published to all subcontractor based on the approval of Owner Change Order at SBC 11/01/22. The November progress photos were shown of the construction. Upper 1, spine, temporary tarps, exterior framing.

Skanska Update

Jim Burrows explained the OAL schedule and overall picture of the project and 100 percent bought out and risk of supply chain is to zero because everything is in procurement or contracted for the whole project. Great job by Consigli and HMFH and all.
