Phase	Construction	Where attend school?	When?
1	<i>STEAM* & Performing Arts wings</i>	<i>Old high school</i>	<i>Completed in Feb./April 2022</i>
2	Humanities wing, Central Spine, Cafeteria, Library, Preschool, District offices	In new STEAM & Performing Arts wings and part of old high school	February 2022 - Fall 2023
3	Athletics wing	In new school plus Red gym	Fall 2023 to December 2024
4	Finish athletic fields and site work, Minuteman Bikeway	In new school	January 2025 to September 2025

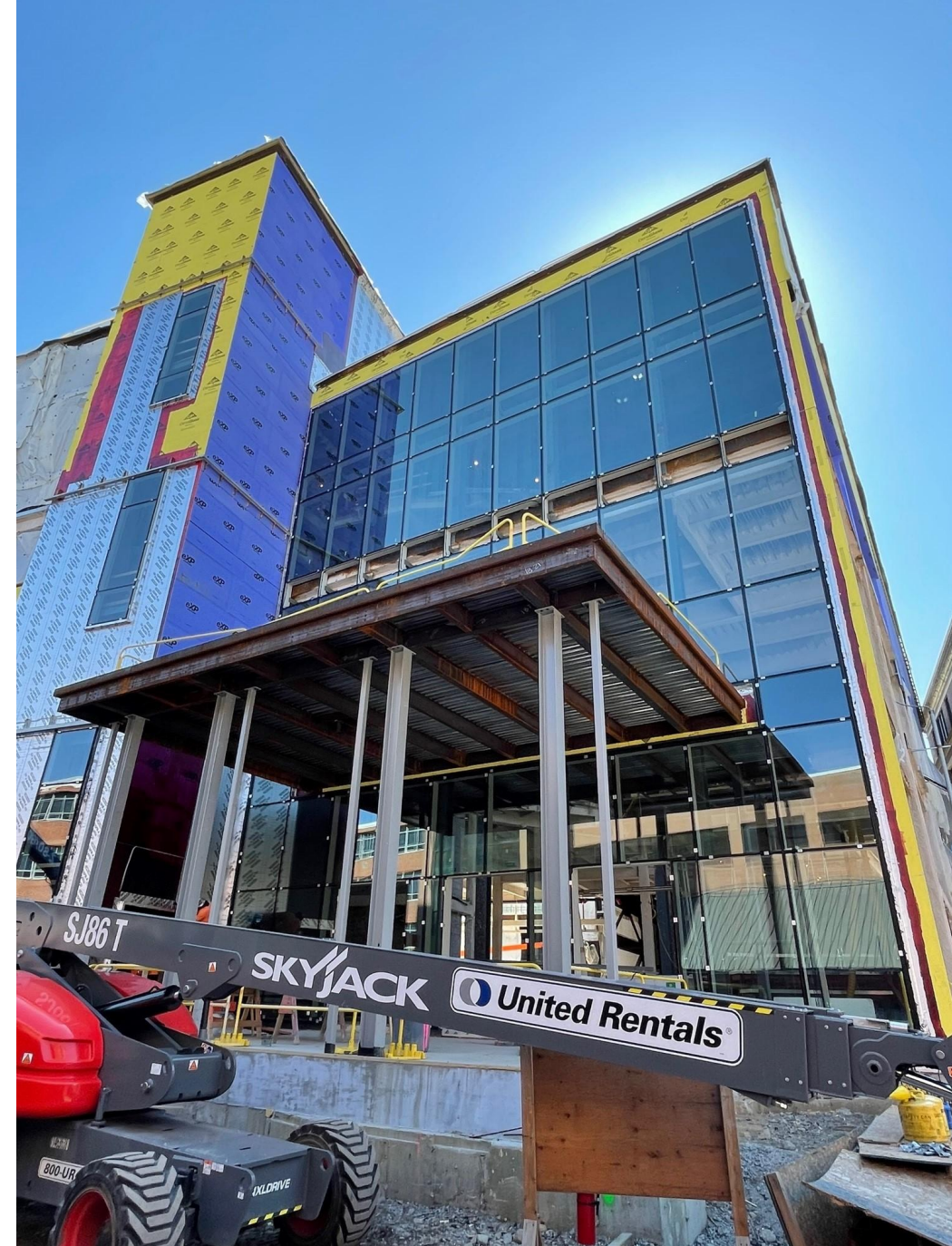

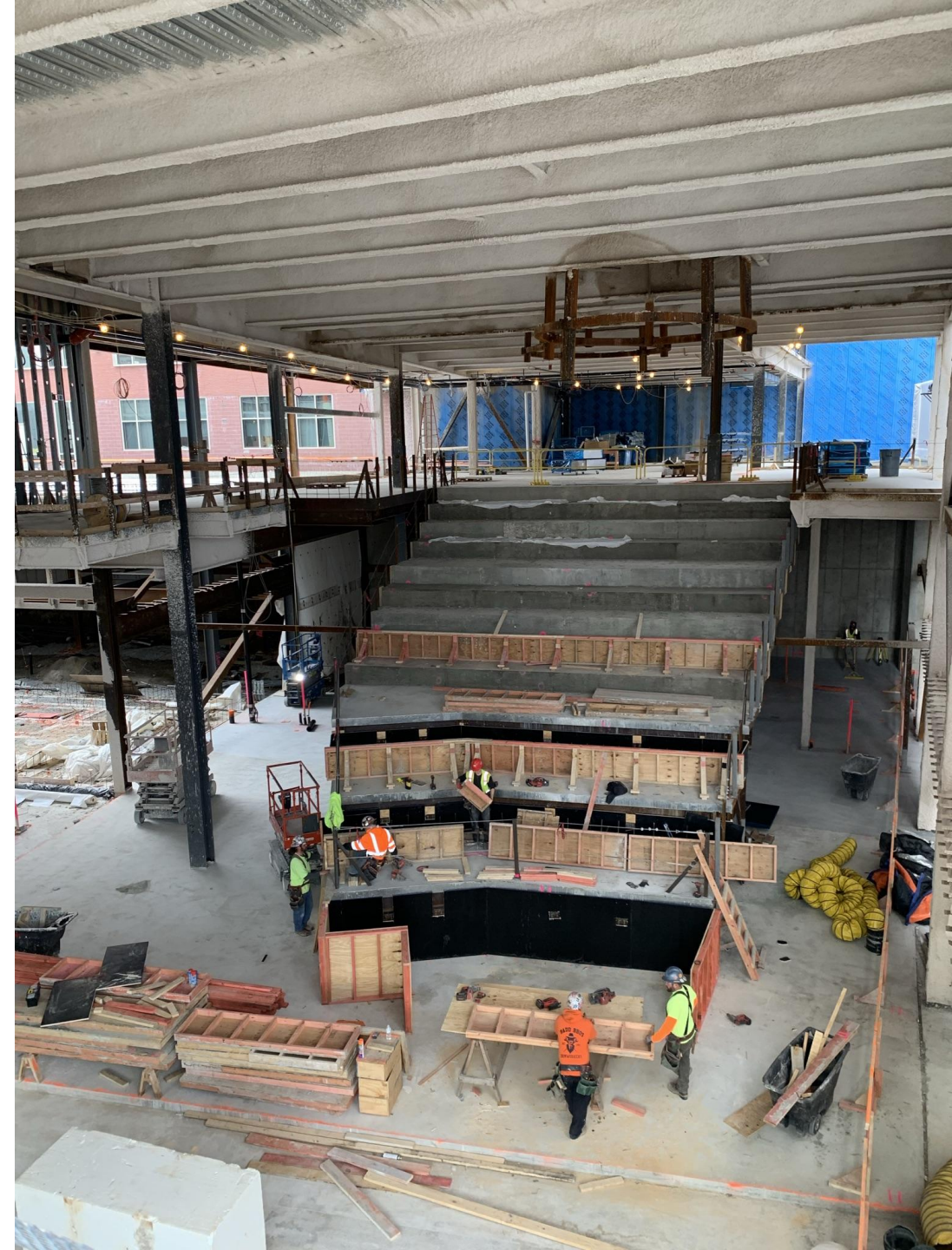
