- Supporting Council on Aging, Senior Center,
   Department of Health & Human Services, Veterans
   Services
- Budget: \$ 8.9m
- Status: Building occupied and in use; project in close-out, punch-list, warranty period











## Town Yard & Municipal Services

- New Administrative and Maintenance Building
- Extensive renovations to existing historical buildings, and new Salt Shed
- Major site work, many unforeseen conditions
- Supporting Public Works, Inspectional Services, IT, Facilities
- Budget: \$ 46.8m
- Status: On-budget, largely on-schedule
