Dear Arlington Resident,

The Town of Arlington is excited to share an opportunity to save money on energy efficiency measures while contributing to our community's sustainable future as part of our Electrify Arlington effort. We have partnered with HomeWorks Energy, a longtime Mass Save® partner, to help residents implement energy efficiency upgrades, many of which are available at reduced or no cost.

We need the participation of residents like you.

**Start with a no-cost Mass Save Home Energy Assessment**

An energy assessment is the first step! An Energy Specialist will examine your home and show you how to save energy and money year-round. If you completed an assessment more than two years ago, you can request a new assessment. Plus, everyone can access new state and federal financial incentives.

Benefits include:

- No-cost sealing of air leaks and 75%-100% off recommended insulation
- Up to a \$10,000 rebate – or \$16,000 for moderate-income households – for an air-source heat pump
- 0% financing for energy efficiency upgrades – up to \$50,000 if installing a heat pump
- No-cost items such as programmable thermostats and advanced power strips
- Increased incentives for income-eligible households – including up to 100% off the cost of a heat pump or a new refrigerator if your home or appliance qualifies
- Up to a \$2,000 federal tax credit for an air-source heat pump and up to \$1,200 for insulation

Arlington has been selected to participate in the Mass Save Community First Partnership, sponsored locally by Eversource and National Grid, to help residents access these energy efficiency programs. HomeWorks Energy has already performed 141 assessments in Arlington this year and has helped many residents improve the energy efficiency of their homes.
