- I. Programs/Activities Update:
 - a. St. Patrick's Day Concert & Breakfast 70 attendees, new time and day of week
 - b. AARP tax appointments running smoothly and accommodating more appointments than previous years. All appointment slots full with waiting list in Arlington and neighboring towns
 - c. Starting in April: Bereavement Group with BIDMC, Living Well with Hearing Loss, "Rediscovering the T" presentation, Scam Info Session with APD and Watertown Savings Bank, Bilingual Story: Celebrating Earth Month
- II. Elderly and Disabled Tax Relief Committee Meeting
 - a. Committee met on March 7 and decisions were made. \$12,533 distributed to 13 applicants, 2 applicants assisted through other sources (20 total applications received).

- a. Second half of EOEA Formula Grant received this month (\$77,245, \$154,490 total, based on \$14 per Arlington resident age 60+ in census.)
