DESIGN CONSIDERATION

- Proposed design balances the project scope and environmental aspects.
- Proposed plan fits within the current budgetary limits.
- Proposed location provides best access to Summer Street.
- Accessibility and supervision.
- Furthest distance from abutters.
- Optimal construction and staging area.
- Central spine for walking and gathering
- Reuse existing trail network.






DESIGN CONSIDERATION

- Proposed pump-track material is natural aggregate materials.
- Proposed location has:
 - Lower value vegetation.
 - Higher quantity of invasive species.
 - Lower quality of overall habitat.
- The proposed location impacts 13% of the forested site, leaving 87% as-is
 - The high quality, including the central clearing and the south facing exposure at Hills Hill habit is preserved.
- Paths stay away from the Red Mulberry trees.





























Proposed biking courses
