- 4. 2023 AYCC Updates (powerpoint)
 - a. 425 clients; 31% increase from previous year
 - b. 9932 sessions (2809 conducted by telehealth
 - c. 30% served were on public insurance or received income-based grant
 - d. 1324 counseling sessions 99 Arlington students, including METCO and Project Success
 - e. 18 clinicians trained in short term Solution Focused Therapy
 - f. 75 residents received case management to assess basic needs and facilitate access to local and statewide services

- g. 16 migrant families sheltering in Arlington received resource coordination and support
- h. Fundraising
 - i. Holiday help (192 families—330 children) during holiday season
 - ii. \$35,000 donations from fundraising
 - iii. \$11,000 in relief funding; \$10,000 Clinton Family fund grant for sheltered migrant families
